## Admission to Teacher Education Candidacy:

Requirements:

1. **All requirements must be fulfilled by the fifth day of the spring semester of the junior year.**
2. 45 or more semester hours
3. Successful completion of freshman English (4 hrs) and freshman math (6 hrs) requirements
4. GPA of 2.50 (cumulative) at NCSU [grades at other institutions do not count].
5. PRAXIS I - 3 parts: Reading, Writing, Math (successfully completed) or Equivalent SAT or ACT score.
6. Completion of AEE 206, Introduction to Teaching Agriculture with a C or better

I have read and understand the requirements for admission to teacher education candidacy. **Further, I understand that if I do not complete these requirements by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the Spring Semester of the junior year (no exceptions), I will not be allowed to take ED 311/ED 312 in the spring of the junior year which will delay student teaching by one year.**

7. Completion of AEE 426, Methods of Teaching Agriculture with a C or better
8. 2.50 GPA - cumulative
9. 24 hours of agricultural content with a C or better
10. Recommendation from advisor and undergraduate coordinator
11. Minimum 92 hours.
12. Completed 4.5 Professional Growth Units
