- 4. GPA of 2.50 (cumulative) at NCSU [grades at other institutions do not count].
- 5. PRAXIS I 3 parts: Reading, Writing, Math (successfully completed) or Equivalent SAT or ACT score.
- 6. Completion of AEE 206, Introduction to Teaching Agriculture with a C or better
