



- > 805




A Look Back at 2020

Macro-Level Trends, 2021

COVID-19 Ramifications Still Here for 3-5 More Years

- Supply Chain Still Recovering
- Confused Signals in Market
- > Inflation
- > Labor Shortages

US Milk & Herd Size Up

- > 9.48M in national herd (+106K YoY)
- > Projected 3% growth in milk! (Avg ~ 1%)

Net Farm Income & Other \$ Factors

- Gov't Payments ~40% of 2020 NFI
 - > Expected to fall for 2021
- Net Cash Farm Income Lower in 2021
 - Cash Receipts Up over 2020
 - > Feed Eating up more than it's share!




Take it Home to NC

Potential for Growth!

- Economic Factors Could be Beneficial to NC Dairy Farmers
 - Commercial/Grade A Fluid Shipping Model
 - On-Farm Processing Model
 - > Growth must be strategic
 - > Location, Location, Location!
 - Mitigation of Seasonal Variance

NC Dairy Impacts

2020

According to the International Dairy Foods
Association, the total economic impact of dairy
products produced and sold in NC in 2020 was... \$12.25B

- > \$3.5B in wages
- \$3B in direct economic impact
- \$634.1M federal tax revenues
- > 2% of NC GDP
