


Figure 2-1. Components of the FAF4 database.

Model using data from shipper surveys conducted by the US Census & USDOT Bureaus

- Estimates freight flows by commodity types
- Agricultural shipments are out-of-scope of the CFS

#### **Ton-miles**

Measures transport demand using both quantity and distance

shipment weight x shipment distance





1 ton-mile = 1 ton of freight moved 1 mile 100 ton-miles = **100 tons of freight** moved 1 mile 100 ton-miles = 1 ton of freight **moved 100 miles** 

# Standard Classification of Transported Goods (SCTG)


- Animal feed
  - Eggs, honey, and other products of animal origin
  - Pet food, waste from animal feeding
- Cereal grains
  - Wheat, corn, rye, barley, oats, grain sorghum, rice
- Live animals/fish
- Logs
- Meat/seafood Milled grain prods.
  - Flour, meal, bakery products
- Other ag prods
  - Soybeans, peanuts, seeds, vegetables, fruit


- Other foodstuffs
  - Dairy, oils (including soy), processed foods


Shipments originating in NC to other US states






### **Domestic Ag Imports**


Shipments from other US states terminating in NC






Shipments from originating and terminating in NC

#### 2018 ag shipments within NC by share of ton-miles












