Requirements:

- Graduation from a Commission on Accreditation for Dietetics Education - approved Didactic Program in Dietetics
Or
- Dietetic Technician, Registered with the Commission on Accreditation for Dietetics Education with a Bachelor's degree in any subject area from an accredited four-year college or university
or
- a Bachelor's of Science degree in Dietetics, Public Health Nutrition or Community Nutrition from an accredited four-year college or university

Responsibilities:

- Develops and implements a plan of care based on medical and nutritional needs for chronic disease patients and WIC clients while considering client's educational background, financial resources, and other available assistance.
- Counsels individuals and families in nutritional principles, food selection and economics, and adapts teaching plans to each individual lifestyle.



- Determines whether an individual is eligible for the WIC program based on medical and/or nutritional criteria.
- If found eligible for WIC services, provides nutrition education and tailors the food package to meet individual needs.
- Evaluates nutritional care and provides follow-up as needed for all client categories to ensure continuity of care.
- Interprets, evaluates, and utilizes pertinent current research relating to nutritional care.
- Provides nutritional consultation to professional and ancillary services staff and related agencies.
- Procures, develops, and evaluates nutrition education material.
- Reports and summarizes progress and activities at regular intervals, prepares periodic and specific reports.
- Other duties as assigned
